Presidio Middle School cell phone policy has changed as a result of misuse of phones during the previous school year. Student phones must be off and out of site at all times when on campus, including the yard and cafeteria, before school and during lunch. Once students have left campus after school they may use their phones.

Please allow my child, whose name appears above, to carry his/her cell phone to school. In order to carry their cell phones to school, I understand that my child must abide by the following expectations.

If students bring a cell phone to school, parents need to sign a contract. If a signed contract is not on file, or the student violates the terms of the contract, his/her cell phone will be confiscated.

Cell phones must remain off and away on school property. There is no exception to this rule. "Off" means turned completely off, "away" means out of sight in a backpack or bag. Phones must not be visible at school.

If a cell phone/electronic device rings, vibrates, or is used for any reason without teacher permission, or is visible anytime during class time, the staff member will make a note of this and inform the main office.

Refusal to surrender a phone or electronic device when asked will result in disciplinary consequences including On Campus Restoration, After School Detention and Saturday School. Parent/Guardian will be contacted.

Students may not take pictures or video of any Presidio students or staff without prior written consent of the person being photographed, per SFUSD policy.

I understand that if my child does not follow these rules and uses the phone during school hours there will be consequences such as but not limited to loss of phone privileges, an administrative member holding on to phone for the day, and/or parent requirement of picking up the phone:

1st Offense: Cell Phone held until the end of the day.

2nd Offense: Cell phone picked up at the end of day by parent/guardian.

3rd Offense: Cell phone to be picked up by a parent/guardian at the end of the week. Cell phone to be turned into main office daily before the start of homeroom for the remainder of the grading period.

I understand that the school shall not be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to my child's phone.
